Introduction:

- ❖ We serve a covenant keeping God and not a Father Christmas God – *Psa. 89:34/ Deut. 28:1-2*

Psa 89:34

³⁴ *My covenant will I not break, nor alter the thing that is gone out of my lips.*

And it shall come to pass, if thou shalt hearken diligently unto the voice of the Lord thy God, to observe and to do all his commandments which I command thee this day, that the Lord thy God will set thee on high above all nations of the earth: ² And all these blessings shall come on thee, and overtake thee, if thou shalt hearken unto the voice of the Lord thy God.

She saith unto him, Grant that these my two sons may sit, the one on thy right hand, and the other on the left, in thy kingdom. ²² But Jesus answered and said, Ye know not what ye ask. Are ye able to drink of the cup that I shall drink of, and to be baptized with the baptism that I am baptized with? They say unto him, We are able.*

Monday June 1, 2026

We Do Not Beg for a Turnaround in the Kingdom – *Mat. 20:20-22*

□ In the kingdom, we do not beg to be blessed, we serve to be blessed – *Exo. 23:25-26/ Luk. 18:28-30*

Ex 23:25-26

²⁵ And ye shall serve the Lord your God, and he shall bless thy bread, and thy water; and I will take sickness away from the midst of thee. ²⁶ There shall nothing cast their young, nor be barren, in thy land: the number of thy days I will fulfil.

Luke 18:28-30

²⁸ Then Peter said, Lo, we have left all, and followed thee. ²⁹ And he said unto them, Verily I say unto you, There is no man that hath left house, or parents, or brethren, or wife, or children, for the kingdom of God's sake, ³⁰ Who shall not receive manifold more in this present time, and in the world to come life everlasting.

□ We do not beg to be promoted; we serve our way into promotion – *Luk. 19:12-13/17-19*

Luke 19:12-13

¹² He said therefore, A certain nobleman went into a far country to receive for himself a kingdom, and to return. ¹³ And he called his ten servants, and delivered them ten pounds, and said unto them, Occupy till I come.

Luke 19:17-19

¹⁷ And he said unto him, Well, thou good servant: because thou hast been faithful in a very little, have thou authority over ten cities. ¹⁸ And the second came, saying, Lord, thy pound hath gained five pounds. ¹⁹ And he said likewise to him, Be thou also over five cities.

❖ God is not looking for who to **enslave**, He is looking for who to **enthron**e – *Luk. 22:25-30/ Dan. 12:3*

²⁵ And he said unto them, The kings of the Gentiles exercise lordship over them; and they that exercise authority upon them are called benefactors. ²⁶ But ye shall not be so: but he that is greatest among you, let him be as the younger; and he that is chief, as he that doth serve. ²⁷ For whether is greater, he that sitteth at meat, or he that serveth? is not he that sitteth at meat? but I am among you as he that serveth. ²⁸ Ye are they which have continued with me in my temptations. ²⁹ And I appoint unto you a kingdom, as my Father hath appointed unto me; ³⁰ That ye may eat and drink at my table in my kingdom, and sit on thrones judging the twelve tribes of Israel.

Tuesday June 2, 2026

We Do Not Beg for a Turnaround in the Kingdom – Mat. 20:20-22

□ We do not beg to be honoured; we serve our way to honour – *Jn 12:24-26*

John 12:24-26

²⁴ *Verily, verily, I say unto you, Except a corn of wheat fall into the ground and die, it abideth alone: but if it die, it bringeth forth much fruit.* ²⁵ *He that loveth his life shall lose it; and he that hateth his life in this world shall keep it unto life eternal.* ²⁶ *If any man serve me, let him follow me; and where I am, there shall also my servant be: if any man serve me, him will my Father honour.*

□ We do not beg for breakthrough; we serve our way into breakthroughs – *Luk. 5:1-8*

Luke 5:1-6

And it came to pass, that, as the people pressed upon him to hear the word of God, he stood by the lake of Gennesaret, ² And saw two ships standing by the lake: but the fishermen were gone out of them, and were washing their nets. ³ And he entered into one of the ships, which was Simon's, and prayed him that he would thrust out a little from the land. And he sat down, and taught the people out of the ship. ⁴ Now when he had left speaking, he said unto Simon, Launch out into the deep, and let down your nets for a draught. ⁵ And Simon answering said unto him, Master, we have toiled all the night, and have taken nothing: nevertheless at thy word I will let down the net. ⁶ And when they had this done, they inclosed a great multitude of fishes: and their net brake.

❖ God is not looking for who to **stress**, He is looking for who to **make whole**—*Pro.13:17/2Cor.5:19-20*

¹⁷ *A wicked messenger falleth into mischief: but a faithful ambassador is health.*

2 Cor 5:19-20

¹⁹ *To wit, that God was in Christ, reconciling the world unto himself, not imputing their trespasses unto them; and hath committed unto us the word of reconciliation. ²⁰ Now then we are ambassadors for Christ, as though God did beseech you by us: we pray you in Christ's stead, be ye reconciled to God.*

Wednesday, June 3, 2026

We Do Not Beg for a Turnaround in the Kingdom – Mat. 20:20-22

□ We do not beg to be free from the oppression of the wicked, we serve our way into liberty
– *Exo. 4:22-23/ Luk. 10:1-2/17-19*

Ex 4:22-23

²² And thou shalt say unto Pharaoh, Thus saith the Lord, Israel is my son, even my firstborn: ²³ And I say unto thee, Let my son go, that he may serve me: and if thou refuse to let him go, behold, I will slay thy son, even thy firstborn.

Luke 10:1-2

After these things the Lord appointed other seventy also, and sent them two and two before his face into every city and place, whither he himself would come. ² Therefore said he unto them, The harvest truly is great, but the labourers are few: pray ye therefore the Lord of the harvest, that he would send forth labourers into his harvest.

□ We do not cry to be free from generational curses, we serve our way into freedom

– Exo. 23:25-26/ Num. 23:8/20

²⁵ And ye shall serve the Lord your God, and he shall bless thy bread, and thy water; and I will take sickness away from the midst of thee. ²⁶ There shall nothing cast their young, nor be barren, in thy land: the number of thy days I will fulfil.

⁸ How shall I curse, whom God hath not cursed? or how shall I defy, whom the Lord hath not defied? ²⁰ Behold, I have received commandment to bless: and he hath blessed; and I cannot reverse it.

– Psa. 89: 20-24/ Mak. 16:15//17-20

²⁰ I have found David my servant; with my holy oil have I anointed him: ²¹ With whom my hand shall be established: mine arm also shall strengthen him. ²² The enemy shall not exact upon him; nor the son of wickedness afflict him. ²³ And I will beat down his foes before his face, and plague them that hate him. ²⁴ But my faithfulness and my mercy shall be with him: and in my name shall his horn be exalted.

□ We do not beg to have children in the kingdom, we serve to be fruitful – *Exo. 23:25-26/ Psa. 127:3*

Ex 23:25-26

²⁵ And ye shall serve the Lord your God, and he shall bless thy bread, and thy water; and I will take sickness away from the midst of thee. ²⁶ There shall nothing cast their young, nor be barren, in thy land: the number of thy days I will fulfil.

Psa 127:3

³ Lo, children are an heritage of the Lord: and the fruit of the womb is his reward.

□ We do not cry to be healed, as we serve God, we are entitled to health and vitality – *Jhn 15:1-2/*

2 Cor. 5:20/ Pro. 13:17

John 15:1-2

I am the true vine, and my Father is the husbandman. ² Every branch in me that beareth not fruit he taketh away: and every branch that beareth fruit, he purgeth it, that it may bring forth more fruit.

²⁰ Now then we are ambassadors for Christ, as though God did beseech you by us: we pray you in Christ's stead, be ye reconciled to God.

We Do Not Beg for a Turnaround in the Kingdom – Mat. 20:20-22

Specifically for this morning

- We do not beg to be favoured; we serve our way into favour – **Pro. 102:13-15/ Psa. 35:27**

Ps 102:13-15

¹³ *Thou shalt arise, and have mercy upon Zion: for the time to favour her, yea, the set time, is come.* ¹⁴ *For thy servants take pleasure in her stones, and favour the dust thereof. ¹⁵ So the heathen shall fear the name of the Lord, and all the kings of the earth thy glory.*

"For thy servants take pleasure in her stones, and favour the dust thereof.

Ps 35:27

²⁷ Let them shout for joy, and be glad, that favour my righteous cause: yea, let them say continually, Let the Lord be magnified, which hath pleasure in the prosperity of his servant.

Practical application: Instead of only praying for favour:

- Support God's work willingly.
- Love what God loves.
- Be committed when no one is watching.
- Remain faithful even in difficult seasons.

□ We do not beg for long life in the kingdom, we serve to a good old age – **Exo. 23:25-26/ Isa. 65:22**

Ex 23:25-26

²⁵ And ye shall serve the Lord your God, and he shall bless thy bread, and thy water; and I will take sickness away from the midst of thee. ²⁶ There shall nothing cast their young, nor be barren, in thy land: the number of thy days I will fulfil.

Isa 65:22

²² They shall not build, and another inhabit; they shall not plant, and another eat: for as the days of a tree are the days of my people, and mine elect shall long enjoy the work of their hands.

❖ God is not looking for who to **use**, He is looking for who to **bless** – **Mak. 10:28-30**

Mark 10:28-30

²⁸ Then Peter began to say unto him, Lo, we have left all, and have followed thee. ²⁹ And Jesus answered and said, Verily I say unto you, There is no man that hath left house, or brethren, or sisters, or father, or mother, or wife, or children, or lands, for my sake, and the gospel's, ³⁰ But he shall receive an hundredfold now in this time, houses, and brethren, and sisters, and mothers, and children, and lands, with persecutions; and in the world to come eternal life.
